Cologne (Germany) Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> December 2024

Dear Parent/Guardian

We are pleased to tell you that a curriculum trip has been arranged for pupils in Year 8 and 9 and 10 (as of September) to visit Cologne in Germany.

The trip will take place from Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> December to Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> December 2024. We will travel by coach and get the ferry from Dover to Calais. Lodging will be in a youth hostel (half board) with ensuite, dormitory style rooms. ## <u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1 – Travel to Germany by coach and ferry (early start). Arrive in time for an evening meal at the hostel and a short visit to a Christmas market.

Day 2 – Breakfast at the hostel. Spend the day in Cologne, visiting the chocolate museum, having a tour of the BayArena Stadium and visiting the cathedral and a Christmas Market. Lunch (not included) will need to be purchased from the Christmas market. Evening meal at the hostel and Ten Pin Bowling in the evening.

Day 3 – Breakfast at the hostel and check out. Spend the day at Phantasialand Theme Park. A packed lunch will be provided but a hot meal (not included) will need to be purchased from Phantasialand. Depart for Calais. Day 4 – Arrive back at school in the morning.

The cost of the trip is £530 per student.

If you would like for your son/daughter to take part in this trip, please complete and return the attached permission slip.

A medical consent form will need to be completed on your child's ParentPay account along with payment of your initial deposit. Your child's place will <u>not</u> be secured until you have returned the reply slip below and completed a medical consent form online.

If assistance is required with the cost of this visit, please contact the school to obtain an application form for the school's Learner support fund. If insufficient contributions are raised to fund this trip, the school reserves the right to cancel this excursion.

Further remittance advice is available within the school's charging and remittance policy available on the school website and parents are encouraged to refer to this.

Students who paid a deposit for the July 2024 trip that was cancelled will get priority and then due to a limited number of places, if demand outweighs available spaces, places will be allocated in the fairest way possible. All students who have paid a deposit will be entered into a random name generator and places allocated according to the names drawn. We will confirm whether your child has been successful as soon as possible after the trip deadline.
